

Killmaster Zero Pest Strips provide continuous protection from cockroaches, moths, silverfish, ants, flies and other insects for up to 4 months.

HOW TO USE: Store Rooms, Storage Spaces and other non-living areas. DO NOT use in food cupboards or food storage and food preparation areas.

Do not open until ready to use. Remove Killmaster Zero Pest Strip completely from the foil sachet. Hang or place in enclosed storage space or non living area to be protected.

Each Killmaster Zero Pest Strip will treat up to 10 cubic metres. Any area which is more than 10 cubic metres may need more than one Zero Pest Strip. Space strips evenly over the space to be treated. Remove strips if people are going to occupy area for prolonged periods. Do not allow humans or pets to sleep in areas when treatment is in progress.

Industrial Rubbish Bins. Do not open until ready to use. Remove Killmaster Zero Pest Strip completely from the foil sachet. Securely attach to the inside of the lid of the rubbish bin. For maximum effect always close lids after use.

Each Killmaster Zero Pest Strip will treat up to 10 cubic metres. Any rubbish bin which is more than 10 cubic metres may need more than one Zero Pest Strip. Space strips evenly over the space to be treated.

WHEN TO REPLACE: Record the date of installation so that the old strip can be replaced with a new full strength strip at the end of the 4 month period or when effectiveness diminishes.

NOT TO BE USED FOR ANY PURPOSE, OR IN ANY MANNER, CONTRARY TO THIS LABEL UNLESS AUTHORISED.

CAUTION: Avoid contact with clothing or other fabrics.

Do not use in food storage cupboards and food preparation areas.

Do not use in infants' rooms or sick rooms where people may be continuously exposed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store in the closed original container in a cool dry place out of reach of children. Do not store in direct sunlight. Dispose of empty foil sachet and used Pest Strip by wrapping in paper, placing in a plastic bag and putting in rubbish.

SAFETY DIRECTIONS: Do not open inner sachet until ready to use. DO NOT

remove the insecticidal strip from the plastic case. DO NOT allow children to play with the strip. Wash hands after use.
