The approval process

Emerging viral pathogens are an ongoing public health concern.

As some viruses can survive on environmental surfaces, and they're less common and predictable, very few EPA-registered disinfectant product labels specify use against these viruses. Also, these pathogens are often unavailable commercially for laboratory testing.

To prepare for such instances, the USEPA allows approved statements to be released by companies whose disinfectant products have passed their stringent testing guidelines.

The public can rest assured the claims made regarding a products effectiveness in combating the emerging pathogen are factual.

Why our products have been approved

Atmosphere disinfectants and sanitisers meet USEPA standards in the following ways.

- Our products have been tested and deemed effective for three of the required viral strains, as stated in sections II and III of the USEPA guidance document.
- Our products have been tested and deemed effective for two other viruses similar to the Coronavirus strain. They are:
 - Feline calicivirus (surrogate for human Norovirus)
 - PEDV (animal Coronavirus)
- Atmosphere is a USEPA registered disinfectant (*EPA reg. No. 92378*) and is also registered with the Australian Government Department of Health (TGA) (*ARTG 303181*).

Which products are approved and how to use them

As stated above, if you're currently following the directions on the label, you're already using the most effective application methods.

Atmosphere All Purpose

- Spray and Wipe
 - Dilute 1:20 (1-part product to 19 parts water)
- Mop and Bucket
 - 1 Cup (200ml) into a standard bucket of hot or cold water
- Use the guide chart on the side of the label for correct and easy measurement

Atmosphere Forte Pro Range (Forte, AG, Pet)

- Spray and Wipe
 - Dilute 1:60 (1-part product to 59 parts water)
- Pressure Washer
 - Dilute 1:60 (1-part product to 59 parts water)
- Mop and Bucket
 - 1/2 Cup (100ml) into a standard bucket of hot or cold water

Atmosphere Foaming Hand Sanitiser

- Ready to use
 - Use as directed

Atmosphere Ready to Use All Purpose Hand & Surface Sanitiser / Deodoriser

- Ready to use
 - Use as directed
